On January 28, 2025, the Department of Information Technology organized an awareness campaign on the topic "Unsausage of Smartphone" in Ariyakulam Village, with Selvi S. Murugeswari, Assistant Professor, and III B.Sc. (IT) students. The campaign aimed to educate the villagers about the responsible and beneficial use of smartphones. The session focused on the positive uses of smartphones, such as accessing educational resources and using digital platforms for government services.
